INSTRUCTIONS

Supplies Used:

- Impressions Abloom Bundle (165611; \$48.50)
- Floral & Gingham Vellum (164713; \$10)
- Basic White Cardstock (166780; \$14)
- Peach Pie Cardstock (163799; \$14)
- Peach Pie Ink Pad (163810; \$9)
- Pool Party Ink Pad (147107; \$9)
- Lemon Lolly Ink Pad (161666; \$9)

- Timid Tiger Ink Pad (165278; \$9)
- Shy Shamrock Stampin' Blends (163825; \$11)
- Peach Pie 3/8" Bordered Ribbon (163783; \$7.50)
- Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653; \$140)
- Paper Trimmer (152392; \$28)
- Stampin' Dimensionals (104430; \$4.25)
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)

Card Measurements

- Peach Pie Cardstock: 4-1/4" x 11", scored at 5-1/2"
- Basic White Cardstock: 4" x 5-1/4" (2 pieces)
- Floral & Gingham Vellum Paper: 3-7/8" x 5-1/8"
- Basic White Cardstock: 3-1/2" x 4-1/2"

Instructions

- Fold the Peach Pie cardstock in half at the score line to create your card base. Adhere one of the 4" x 5-1/4" pieces of Basic White cardstock inside the card. Adhere the other piece of 4" x 5-1/4" Basic White cardstock to the front of the card.
- 2) Adhere the Pool Party Gingham Vellum to the front of the card, centering onto the Basic White Cardstock. *Tip: using a sponge or paper towel to "dab" glue to the back of the vellum so that you have a very thin layer this will help keep the vellum from curling and showing thru on the front side of the vellum.*



- 3) Run the 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" piece of Basic White cardstock through the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine and die-cut using the oval die from the Impressions Abloom Bundle Dies. Stamp the sentiment in the upper left corner using Timid Tiger ink.
- 4) Using the Peach Pie ink pad, stamp the larger detailed flower randomly onto the Basic White oval. Repeat as desired. Ink up the coordinating bold flower using Peach Pie ink, stamp off once on your scratch paper and then stamp over the detailed flower. Repeat with the other flowers.
- 5) Using the Pool Party ink pad, stamp the small detailed flower randomly on the Basic White oval. Repeat as desired. Ink up the coordinating bold flower using Pool party ink, stamp off once on your scratch paper, and then stamp over the detailed flower. Repeat with other flowers. Stamp the "inside circle" of each flower using the circle stamp and Lemon Lolly ink.
- 6) Optional: use the tip and lid of the Light Shy Shamrock Blend to splatter ink on the Basic White cardstock.
- 7) Wrap the Peach Pie ribbon around the bottom of the oval and tie into a knot. Adhere the cardstock to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals to finish.
