Supplies Used:

- Rustic Centerpiece Stamp Set (166186; \$25)
- Simply Said Stamp Set (163756; \$17)
- Country Woods Designer Paper (163393; \$12.50)
- Basic White Cardstock (166780; \$14)
- Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad (132708; \$8)
- Gray Granite Blends Combo Pack (154886; \$11)
- Pool Party Blends Combo Pack (154894; \$11)

- Highland Heather Blends Combo Pack (154887; \$11)
- Linen Thread (104199; \$5)
- Everyday Arches Dies (164629; \$29)
- Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653; \$140)
- Paper Trimmer (152392; \$28)
- Stampin' Dimensionals (104430; \$4.25)
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)

Card Measurements

- Basic White Cardstock: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- Country Woods Paper, Pattern 1: 4" x 5-1/4"
- Country Woods Paper, Pattern 2: 2" x 5-1/4"
- Bsic White Cardstock: 3" x 4-1/4" (for die-cutting)

Instructions

- 1. Fold the Basic cardstock in half at the score line to create your card base.
- 2. Adhere the Country Woods Paper, Pattern 2" to the 4" x 5-1/4" piece of Country Woods Paper. Wrap Linen Thread 3 times around the Paper, leaving long tails for a bow. Tie a very loose bow on the left side, so that you can untie it later if need be.
- 3. Adhere the Country Woods Paper to the front of the card.
- 4. Using the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, die-cut the 2-1/2" x 3-3/4" Everyday Arches Die from the 3" x 4-1/4" piece of Basic White Cardstock. (*Tip: die #6 if you start with die #1 as the smallest.*)
- 5. Stamp the image onto the right side of the die-cut using Black Memento ink. Stamp the sentiment to the left of the stamped image using the same ink.
- 6. Color in the image using the Dark Gray Granite Blend, the Pool Party Blends, and the Dark Highland Heather Blend.
- 7. Adhere the stamped die-cut to the right side of the front of the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 8. If necessary, re-tie the Linen Thread so that it's to the left of the die-cut to finish.
