INSTRUCTIONS

- Perfectly Pears Stamp Set (166147; \$20)
- Beautiful Gallery Designer Paper (165196; \$12.50)
- Fluid 100 Watercolor Paper (149612; \$9)
- Lost Lagoon Cardstock (133679; \$14)
- Daffodil Delight Cardstock (119683; \$14)
- Basic White Cardstock (166780; \$14)
- Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad (132708; \$8)
- Daffodil Delight Ink Pad (147094; \$9)
- Old Olive Ink Pad (147090; \$9)
- Stampin' Spritzer (126185; \$6)
- Stylish Shapes Dies (159183; \$30)
- Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653; \$140)
- Paper Trimmer (152392; \$28)
- Stampin' Dimensionals (104430; \$4.25)
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)

Card Measurements

- Lost Lagoon Cardstock: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- Basic White Cardstock: 4" x 5-1/4"
- Beautiful Gallery Paper: 3-1/2" x 3-3/4"
- Daffodil Delight Cardstock: 3/4" x 4-1/4"
- Watercolor Paper: 1/2" x 1-3/4"
- Watercolor Paper: 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" (for die-cutting)

Instructions

1. Fold the Lost Lagoon Cardstock in half at the score line to create your card base. Adhere the 4" x 5-1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock inside the card.
2. Adhere Beautiful Gallery Paper to the center front of the card, about 3/4" down from the top.
3. Adhere the 3/4" x 4-1/4" strip of Daffodil Delight cardstock about 3/4" up from the bottom of the Beautiful Gallery Paper.
4. Run the 2-1/2" piece of Watercolor Paper through the Cut & Emboss Machine and die-cut the 2-1/8" circle using the Stylish Shapes Dies. Stamp the outline image of the 2 pears onto the die-cut circle using Old Olive ink.
5. Stamp the bold pear image inside the outline image using Daffodil Delight ink. (Optional: tap the ink pad onto an acrylic block and pick up some of the ink using a damp (not wet) small paint brush; fill in the pears as desired.)
6. Using an acrylic block, tap some Old Olive ink onto the block and add water using the Stampin' Spritzer. Using a small paint brush, pick up some of the ink and fill in the leaves. (Tip: you want enough water on your acrylic block to think out the ink but not make it too watery.)
7. Stamp "thank you" onto the right side of the 1/2" strip of Watercolor Paper using Black Memento ink. Adhere the left side to the back of the circle and then adhere to card using Stampin' Dimensionals to finish.
