

Coffee & A Card

Measurements

- Early Espresso Cardstock: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- Basic Beige Cardstock: 4" x 5-1/4"
- Autumn Toile Designer Series Paper: 4" x 5-1/4"
- Basic Beige Cardstock: 2-1/2" x 3-3/4" (for die-cutting)
- Pecan Pie Cardstock: 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" (scrap for die-cutting)

Instructions

- 1) Fold the Early Espresso cardstock in half at the score line to create your card base.
- 2) Adhere the 4" x 5-1/4" pieces of Basic Beige cardstock inside the card.
- 3) Adhere the 4" x 5-1/4" piece of Autumn Toile Designer Paper to the front of the card.
- 4) Run the 2-1/2" x 3-3/4" piece of Basic Beige Cardstock through the Mini Cut & Emboss Machine and die-cut using the label die from the Label Me Grateful Dies. Stamp the sentiment onto the Basic Beige die-cut using Early Espresso ink. Sponge the edges of the die-cut using a Sponge Dauber and the Pecan Pie ink pad; adhere to the front of the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 5) Run the scrap piece of Pecan Pie cardstock through the Mini Cut & Emboss Machine and die-cut 2 of the acorn branches using the die from the Label Me Grateful Dies. Sponge the edges of the acorns using Pecan Pie ink and a Sponge Dauber; color in the branch using the Early Espresso Marker. (*Tip: use the side of the Brush Tip so that you don't hurt your Marker.*)
- 6) Adhere one of the acorn die-cuts to the inside of the card in the lower right corner; adhere the other acorn die-cut to the sentiment label on the front of the card to finish.
