

Coffee & A Card

Measurements

- Real Red Cardstock: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- Basic White Cardstock: 4" x 5-1/4"
- Basic White Cardstock: 3-3/4" x 5"
- Traditions of Christmas Specialty Paper: 3-5/8" x 4-7/8"
- Real Red Two-Tone Cardstock: 6" x 6"



Instructions

- 1) Fold the 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" Real Red cardstock in half at the score line to create your card base.
- 2) Adhere the 4" x 5-1/4" pieces of Basic White cardstock inside the card.
- 3) Adhere the Traditions of Christmas Specialty Paper to the 3-3/4" x 5" piece of Basic White cardstock.
- 4) Wrap Ribbon around the 3-3/4" x 5" piece of Basic White cardstock and tie into a knot or bow on the left side. Adhere to the front of the card.
- 5) With the Christmas Words folder open and the Stampin' Up logo on the left, place the dies, with the cutting side up, onto the left side of the fold until it "clicks" in place. Place the Real Red Two-Tone cardstock on top of the die.
- 6) Run the Real Red Two-Tone cardstock through the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine using the Christmas Words Collage Hybrid Embossing Folder and die-cut the words from the folder. Save the rest of the words to use later.
- 7) Using a sanding block, lightly sand the die-cut words of choice so that the white core starts to show through. Adhere to the card, to the right of the White Ribbon knot, using Stampin' Dimensionals to finish.
