• Soft Sea Foam Cardstock: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"

• Basic White Cardstock: 4" x 5-1/4"

• Bubble Bath Cardstock: 4" x 5-1/4"

• Bubble Bath Cardstock: 1" x 3" (for die-cutting)


• Traditions of Christmas Designer Paper: 3-3/4" x 5"

• Traditions of Christmas Designer Paper: 3/4" x 5-1/4"



Instructions

- 1) Fold the Soft Sea Foam cardstock in half at the 4-1/4" score line to create your card base.
- 2) Adhere the 3/4" x 5-1/4" piece of Traditions of Christmas Designer Paper to the left side of the 4" x 5-1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock; adhere inside the card base.
- 3) Using a Paper Trimmer, cut the 3-3/4" x 5" piece of Traditions of Christmas Designer Paper at 2-1/2" on the short side. Cut the 2-1/2" strip at 2-3/4". Cut the 1-1/4" piece at 2".
- 4) Adhere the cut pieces of Designer Paper with Piece A in the upper left, Piece B in lower left, Piece C in upper right, and Piece D in lower right of the 4" x 5-1/4" piece of Bubble Bath cardstock.
- 5) Stamp the sentiment onto the 1" strip of Bubble Bath cardstock using the Real Red ink pad. Die-cut using the smallest die from the Textured Notes dies. Adhere to the front of the card as desired using Stampin' Dimensionals to finish.
