## Coffee & A Card November 5, 2025

## Measurements

- Basic White Thick Cardstock: 4-1/4" x 11", scored at 2", 4", and 5-1/2" and 3" scrap for die-cutting
- Early Espresso Cardstock:
  - 1-1/4" x 4" (2 pieces)
  - 1-3/4" x 4" (2 pieces)
  - 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" (for die-cutting)
- Gathering Together Designer Series Specialty Paper:
  - 1" x 3-3/4" (2 pieces/leaf pattern)
  - 1-1/2" x 3-3/4" (2 pieces/plaid pattern)



## Instructions

1) Fold the 4-1/4" X 11" piece of Thick Basic White Cardstock at a Mountain Fold at the 2" score line, Valley Fold at the 4" score line, and Mountain Fold at 5-1/2" score line.



- 2) Adhere the two 1" strips of Designer Paper to the 1-1/4" strips of Early Espresso cardstock, and the two 1-1/2" strips of Designer Paper to the 1-3/4" strips of Early Espresso Cardstock.
- 3) Adhere one of the 1-1/4" x 4" pieces of Early Espresso cardstock to the bottom inside of the card using Stampin' Dimensionals. This will create the ledge for the easel.
- 4) Use adhesive to adhere the top part of the card base section measuring 1-1/2" x 4 1/4" so that it is sealed shut, as shown.
- 5) Adhere the 2 remaining layers of Early Espresso/Designer Paper to the card as shown.
- 6) Run the scraps of Basic White and Early Espresso cardstock through the Cut & Emboss Machine and die-cut the Early Espresso cardstock using the largest Stylish Shapes Circle Die; and the Basic White cardstock using the 2nd largest Stylish Shapes Circle die.
- 7) Stamp the deer onto the Basic White circle using Early Espresso ink. Create a mask by stamping the image again onto a piece of Masking Paper, cut out with scissors, and then layer onto the deer. Stamp the trees around the deer as desired using Old Olive ink. Remove mask and adhere the stamped circle to the Early Espresso circle. Adhere to the bottom panel of the card as shown in sample to finish.
