

# Coffee & A Card

## January 14, 2026



### Measurements

- Misty Moonlight Cardstock: 4-1/4" x 11", score at 1-3/4" and 7-1/4"
- Basic White Cardstock: 3-3/4" x 5-1/4" score at 1/2" at top
- Kintsugi Inspirations Paper: 1-1/2" x 4" and 3-1/2" x 4"
- Misty Moonlight Cardstock: 2-3/4" x 3-3/4"
- Kintsugi Inspirations Paper: 2-1/2" x 3-1/2"
- Basic White Cardstock: 2-3/4" x 3-3/4" (for die-cutting)

### Instructions

- 1) Fold the 4-1/4" X 11" piece of Misty Moonlight Cardstock at the score lines and burnish well with your Bone Folder.
- 2) Adhere the 3-1/2" x 4" piece of Kintsugi Inspirations Paper to the top flap and the 1-1/2" x 4" piece to the bottom flap.
- 3) Adhere the 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" piece of Kintsugi Inspirations Paper to the 2-3/4" x 3-3/4" piece of Misty Moonlight cardstock.
- 4) Run the 2-3/4" x 3-3/4" piece of Basic White cardstock through the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine and die-cut use the rectangle floral die. Using your Paper Trimmer, line up the outside edge of the die-cut to the inside line of Paper Trimmer and trim. Do this on all 4 sides. Adhere to the Misty Moonlight piece from Step #3 and adhere to the *top flap only* using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 5) Using the 3-3/4" x 5-1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock, and using the 1/2" score line at the top, stamp the large floral image using Misty Moonlight ink. Stamp the sentiment beside the floral image using the same ink. Squeeze the lid of the Misty Moonlight ink pad to get ink on the lid and then use the Wink Of Stella brush to highlight the flowers as desired. Color in the leaves using Lost Lagoon ink pad and a damp (*not wet*) Water Painter.
- 6) Fold the 1/2" score link back (*mountain fold*) and then reopen. Place the cardstock at the top of the inside score link, just a smidge down from the score line, and place adhesive on the 1/2" area. Close the Misty Moonlight cardstock down and give it a few minutes to dry.
- 7) Cut a small (*less than 1/8"*) strip from the side of the Mini Stampin' Dimensionals. Cut in half and adhere to the outside edges of the Misty Moonlight cardstock bottom scored flap - this will create a pocket. Slip the bottom of stamped Basic White cardstock inside the flap - make sure it slides easily.
- 8) Finish by tying a large bow using the White with Gold Ribbon and adhere to front of card.
