

Coffee & A Card

Measurements

- Highland Heather Cardstock: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- Basic White Cardstock: 4" x 5-1/4"
- Calypso Coral Cardstock: 3-7/8" x 5-1/8"
- Basic White Cardstock: 3-3/4" x 5"

Instructions

- 1) Fold the 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" Highland Heather cardstock in half at the score line to create your card base.
- 2) Adhere the 4" x 5-1/2" piece of Basic White cardstock inside the card. Decorate as desired.
- 3) Stamp the sentiment onto the 3-3/4" x 5" Basic White cardstock using Gorgeous Grape ink. Stamp at least 1-1/2" down from the top of the Basic White cardstock. Create a mask that is 1" tall x 4" long; cover the sentiment with your mask.
- 4) Stamp the large flower, avoiding the stem, using Calypso Coral ink. Stamp above and below the mask as desired.
- 5) Stamp the leaf image as desired using Granny Apple Green ink.
- 6) Stamp the small flower using Highland Heather ink. (Optional: I stamped it again several times without re-inking the stamp to create a shadow.)
- 7) Remove the mask.
- 8) Adhere the Basic White cardstock to the Calypso Coral cardstock using adhesive. Adhere this piece to the front of the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 9) To finish, add 3 of the Pearls of Beauty embellishments as desired.
