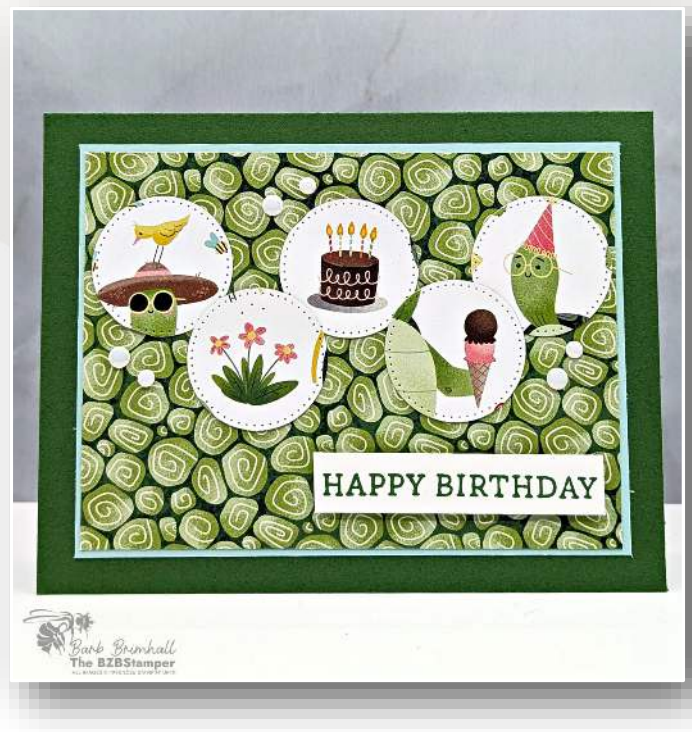


Coffee & A Card

March 25, 2026

Measurements

- Garden Green Cardstock: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- Basic White Cardstock: 4" x 5-1/4"
- Pool Party Cardstock: 3-5/8" x 4-7/8"
- Turtle-y Cute Designer Paper #1: 3-1/2" x 4-3/4"
- Turtle-y Cute Designer Papers (various): Scraps
- Basic White Cardstock: 1/2" x 2-1/2"



Instructions

- 1) Fold the 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" Garden Green cardstock in half at the score line to create your card base.
- 2) Adhere the 4" x 5-1/2" piece of Basic White cardstock inside the card. Decorate as desired.
- 3) Adhere the 3-1/2" x 4-3/4" piece of Turtle-y Cute Designer Paper to the Pool Party cardstock. Adhere to the front of the card.
- 4) Using the scraps of Turtle-y Cute Designer Paper, run through the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine and die-cut five various images using the 1-1/4" (second smallest) die from the Stylish Shapes Dies. *(If you have a 1-1/4" circle punch, that will work too!)*
- 5) Adhere the 5 circles to the front of the card as shown in the sample. You can either use Stampin' Dimensionals or regular adhesive.
- 6) Stamp the sentiment onto the 1/2" strip of Basic White cardstock using Garden Green ink and adhere to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 7) To finish, add the White Pearls of Beauty embellishments as desired.
