

Coffee & A Card

Measurements

- Night of Navy Cardstock: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- Basic White Cardstock: 4" x 5-1/4"
- Golden Glow Cardstock: 3-5/8" x 4-7/8"
- Basic White Cardstock: 3-1/2" x 4-3/4"

Instructions

- 1) Fold the 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" Night of Navy cardstock in half at the score line to create your card base.
- 2) Adhere the 4" x 5-1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock inside the card. Decorate as desired.
- 3) Using the Night of Navy ink pad, stamp the "speckles" around the outside right and bottom of the card base.
- 4) Stamp the sentiment in the upper left corner of the 3-1/2" x 4-3/4" piece of Basic White cardstock using Night of Navy ink.
- 5) Stamp the peacock onto the cardstock using the Night of Navy Ink. Stamp the long branch and short branch on either side of the peacock using the same ink.
- 6) Using a small Blending Brush, sponge Hydrangea Hue around the stamped peacock to create a shadow.
- 7) Color in the branch/leaves using the Light Shaded Spruce Blend.
- 8) Color in the peacock beak and tail eyespots using the Dark Golden Glow Blend.
- 9) Color in the peacock crest and body using Light Hydrangea Hue Blend.
- 10) Press a clean acrylic block into the Hydrangea Hue ink pad to pick up a small amount of ink. Pick up the ink using the Wink of Stella Glitter Brush and color in the tail feathers.
- 11) Adhere the White cardstock to the Golden Glow cardstock, lining up on the top and left sides. Adhere to the card in the upper left corner as shown in the sample to finish.
